Training & Ground Rules

- * All members must be on time for their class and assist with setting up and packing up equipment for each night. Dogs can be exercised before set up commences.
- * All dogs must be restrained while equipment is being set up or packed away.
- * Dog droppings must be picked up and removed from the grounds. Bags are located on the container door.
- * Dogs must be under control while training. If a dog does run off, it must be recalled promptly before it interferes with others who are trying to train.*
- * Positive reinforcement only is permitted (food or toy rewards). No harsh treatment of dogs will be tolerated.
- * Dogs must wear a flat, quick-release collar, as it is preferable for dogs to run off lead and 'naked' (no collar). No choker/check chains are to be used.
- * We strongly recommend that your dog be fully immunised or titre tested for canine health.
- * Family members and friends are welcome to come to watch provided they do not interfere with training.
- * Members in green class (beginners) are not permitted to use equipment without the supervision of an instructor appointed by the club.
- * Closed shoes need to be worn while training.
- * Smoking is not permitted near training or seating area.
- * All members and their guests must follow directions given by instructors and/or committee members whilst on the club grounds.
- * Please be mindful of other people's training needs and ensure that you and your dog/s do not hinder others.
